**NOTICE OF RATE INCREASE**

January 19, 2026

Dear Picoso Member,

The Picoso Water Supply Corporation ("Corporation") Board of Directors held a public meeting on Thursday, January 15, 2026 and voted to increase the monthly rates for water service for all members.

The purpose of the rate increase is to make necessary upgrades to our system due to the age of our facilities and increased demands. Through the years, the Board has worked to keep rates as low as possible, however this has limited the funds in reserves to make these necessary upgrades to our infrastructure to continue supplying quality water to all members, as well as meeting state requirements.

The new rates will take effect on March 16, 2026 and will begin with the March billing period (payments due April 2026). The rate changes are as follows:
